Hand Sewing class description:

Creative kids have an incredible place to learn and master the great art of sewing! Hand Sewing classes for ages 5 and up are designed to be small (maximum five students) to provide the attention necessary for optimal learning. Students learn and build valuable, lifelong skills like: how to carry a project from concept to completion, patience, artistry, reading patterns and visualizing in 3-dimensions. All sewing tools and beginning patterns are provided for boys and girls for use during class. We begin with Winky Cherry's educational series developed just for children to learn the basics of sewing felt shapes as they learn to choose, measure, cut, thread a needle, make a knot, stitch, and lock stitch. Depending on age, skill level and class time, students can progress, at their own pace, to more advanced projects like accessories, gifts, small quilts, or embroidery. All hand sewing project supplies are all included in class fee.

Machine Sewing class description:

Creative kids have an incredible place to learn and master the great art of sewing! Machine sewing classes for ages 7 and up are designed to be small (maximum five students) to provide the attention necessary for optimal learning. Students learn and build valuable, lifelong skills like: how to operate a sewing machine, carry a project from concept to completion, patience, artistry, reading patterns and visualizing in 3-dimensions. Sewing machines, tools and beginning patterns are provided for boys and girls. We begin with DIRECTIONS, a series of educational sewing patterns developed just for young people. Then students progress on to sew clothes, gifts, accessories, stuffed animals, quilts, etc.

For a student's first machine sewing project, please choose to either:

1. send an extra materials fee of \$10.00 with student (to give to instructor on first day-cash or check) in exchange for supplies from instructor.

OR

2. purchase respective supplies below at fabric store before first class (and bring supplies to first class). Beginners may choose either a baby blanket or a tote bag as their first project. (Tote bag may be sewn into a backpack if desired.) The following respective supplies are needed for first day:

-Baby blanket supplies: 1.25 yards of flannel fabric, and good quality contrasting color thread (for decorative stitching)

-Tote Bag supplies: 5/8 yard of woven fabric (avoid stretchy, slippery or directional print fabrics!), good quality matching color thread, and 3 yards of cable cord (size 250 or 3/8") for drawstring.

***Continuing students who've previously taken machine sewing with Kathy will not repeat the beginning project, but must please contact instructor, Kathy Lynch, directly at 720-402-8057 for supply list to purchase respective supplies before first class.
