

there's something off somewhere, but you just can't put your finger on it.




The Very Sleepy Sloth by Andrew Murray,


Scaredy Squirrel Goes Camping by Melanie Watt, \$7.99




The Octopus Escapes by Maile Meloy, illus. by Felicita Sala, \$17.99


Cat on the Bus by Aram Kim, \$7.99


Hello, Hedgehog!: Let's Go Swimming! by Norm Feuti, \$4.99




Spy School Revolution by Stuart Gibbs, \$8.99

God has a special mission for each of us! By recounting the stories of both well-known and newer saints, this book helps readers learn that there is no one single way to live a life of sanctity.




How Great Is Our God by Louie Giglio, illus. by Nicola Anderson, \$17.99


Baby Hedgehog Finger Puppet Book by Chronicle Books, illus. by Yu-Hsuan Huang, \$7.99
