## Tier I // Campus Improvements // \$65,000

The needs for Tier I of the Paddle Raiser are pulled from the comprehensive facilities assessment completed in 2020 for the Parish and School campus. A cluster of near-term needs comprises this tier.

## Timeline: Summer 2022

- Tuckpoint repairs on south and west facing walls of the school building: Eroding mortar has begun to compromise the building structure, allowing water to seep inside at the roof level. We want to restore integrity to the structure and the historic look of the building.
Estimated cost: \$38,000.
- The irrigation system is estimated to last for up to four more years before repair is needed; however in response to increased water bills and known excess water use we have opted to address the sprinkler system this year. Estimated cost: \$17,000.
- Replace stair coverings over three flights of stairs. This is the main staircase used by all students upon entry and exit of the building at beginning and end of day, lunch and recess times. It is well used and in need of repair.
Estimated cost: \$10,000



## Tier II // Student Impact: // \$50,000

Timeline: Summer 2022

It is arguable that the turf on the upper playground sees more use than any other square footage on the campus. At every recess students are playing multiple full-field games. Some third graders play a rousing game of soccer while, simultaneously, fourth graders imitate their
favorite football teams, and vice versa. At any given time a game of tag goes through the middle of these games. The turf is well used, daily, by all grade levels, and it's no surprise that it is ready to be replaced. The entire playground was replaced in 2019 through generous parent support of that
year's gala paddle raiser. This year, we hope to complete the project by replacing the turf in the center of the playground.
Estimated cost: \$50,000.


## Tier III // Teacher Appreciation: // \$25,000

## Timeline: As major anniversaries are achieved

SVdP School greatly appreciates the partnership between home and school - parents, teachers, and staff all working together to provide a Catholic education for our children. Our dedicated staff contributes mightily to the mission of Catholic education by their witness to a life lived in Christ. Our teachers contribute to the mission by their witness and by their outstanding competence in the classroom. SVdP can boast the highest levels of student proficiency in reading and
literacy in the Archdiocese, as of January 2022. Knowing that teachers are the number one factor influencing student academic success, we are assured that our teachers are the best! Tier 3 of this year's paddle raiser allows us to embed a show of appreciation for our teachers by planning to give major anniversary bonuses at $5,10,15,20+$ years of dedicated service to SVdP School. Archdiocesan school teachers are limited in salary based on the provided scale which
uses a formula factoring in level of education and years of experience. Catholic schools outside the Archdiocese are able to offer a starting salary nearly $25 \%$ higher than within the Archdiocesan scale. The Archdiocese is working to correct this disparity, but SVdP would like to go above and beyond to express appreciation to our teachers. Giving to the paddle raiser is one way of saying thanks to our teachers!
Goal: \$25,000.
