How can the crucifixion and death of Jesus possibly be glory? Because the cross is Jesus' perfect obedience to the Father, it is the battlefield where He conquers your sin and death and it is the powerful reminder that God is in control of His world.


This last point is important. God is in control. He transforms every darkness in your life that you give to Him into healing and glory. God really is more powerful than any darkness we can experience. We ask His glory to shine through and it will. LITURGY & PRAYER



St. Margaret of Cortona was born into a farming family in Tuscany, her mother died when Margaret was seven. Her father remarried, but life with her stepmother was so difficult that St. Margaret moved out of the home and instead chose to live with a man named Arsenio, though they weren't married. They had been living together for nine years when she gave birth to a son. Knowing in her heart that this wasn't the life that God intended for her to have, she prayed for purity. One day while waiting for Arsenio, his dog led her into the forest where she found Arsenio murdered. So shocked was St. Margaret that she fell into a life of penance. She and her son returned to Laviano, but still found her stepmother to be as unwelcoming as ever. They then went to Cortona, and eventually her son became a friar. Three years after her conversion, St. Margaret followed in her son's footsteps and became a Franciscan tertiary.


